Types of houses according to the quality of construction materials (INDEC, 2010):

It refers to the quality of the materials with which the houses are built (predominant material of the floors and ceilings), taking into account the solidity, resistance and insulating capacity, as well as its termination.

The quality of the materials is classified:

- Quality I: the house has strong and solid materials both on the floor and on the roof; It has a ceiling.
- Quality II: the house has strong and solid materials both on the floor and on the roof. And ceilings without ceilings or lower quality materials in floors.
- Quality III: the house has poorly resistant and solid materials on the roof and floors.
- Quality IV: the house has low quality materials in floors and ceilings.
